PROCUREMENT AND SUPPLY AUDITOR'S TRAINING PROGRAM: AUDITING SKILLS AND METHODOLOGY

Introduction

The Procurement and Supplies Professionals and Technicians Board (PSPTB), as a Professional regulator, is mandated to train, register, and regulate the conduct of procurement and supply auditors in Tanzania. In that regard, PSPTB has developed a professional training program in auditing skills and methodology for Procurement and supply auditors to enhance professionalism and professional practices in auditing procurement and supply chain management.

Program Objectives

The training program for Procurement and Supply Auditors is designed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of the practical aspects of procurement and supply audit, particularly how it fits into an overall audit and functional review strategy. It will equip trainees with auditing knowledge and skills in line with the professional code of ethics and standards.

Equally, trained professionals who complete the program will attempt qualifying examinations. ***Only participants who will pass the qualifying examination will be eligible for an award of a Certified Procurement and Supply Auditor Competence Certificate.***

Who Should Attend?

This course is ideal for experienced procurement and supply professionals executing and overseeing procurement and supply processes. It will equip the trainees with best practices and methodologies for conducting effective audits in the procurement and supply areas.

The program is specifically designed to suit all practitioners registered under the Approved and Authorized category as per PSPTB Membership Registration Criteria who are responsible or can be engaged to audit procurement and Supply processes, stock verification, and asset management in both the public and private sectors.

Training Modules

The designed modules focus on the introduction of Procurement and Supply for an Auditing perspective, procurement and supply audit scope, conducting procurement and supply audit, risk assessment, ethical consideration, compliance with regulatory frameworks, and Audit report writing as indicated in Table 1:
