### Paper Writers' invitation and guide for abstract preparation

The Conference Organizing Committee welcomes Procurement and Supply Professionals, Academicians, researchers, Policy Makers, and other authors to submit their abstracts of between 200 - 350 words. The author of each accepted paper will be required to present their respective paper in the conference venue.

### Conditions;

- a) The authors should make sure that papers are grounded in the field findings, professional practices, and experiences.
- b) The abstract content and learning experiences should be consistent with the theme and focus on one of the sub-themes highlighted hereunder;
- c) Plagiarism is an unacceptable professional misconduct and cannot be tolerated. If an author is found to commit an act of plagiarism, the paper will be rejected at any stage.
- d) Authors will not be allowed to send a representative to present his/her paper on their behalf.
